Lynn Shapiro Snyder to Join Trustmark Board

LAKE FOREST, Ill.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--June 12, 2006--Lynn Shapiro Snyder, a senior member of the Health Care and Life Sciences Practice at national law firm Epstein Becker & Green (EBG), will be joining the board of directors of Trustmark Mutual Holding Company.
